Middlesex Suite (Civic Centre, Uxbridge High Street, Uxbridge)

The Box Office and panel events are in the Middlesex Suite. Doors open 10am for ticket collection. There are toilets in the Middlesex Suite and unisex toilets in Uxbridge Library 100m away. Visit www.yashot.co.uk to buy tickets.

Directions to Uxbridge Library & Event Details

All author signings are in the Atrium (ground floor). All authors will sign for an hour after the end of their event, including those doing events in the Civic Centre. (Jo Cotterill will sign after her second event.)

Workshop events are in the 5th Floor Study Area of Uxbridge Library.

In Conversation events are on the 6th Floor.

From the Box Office, go diagonally across the Civic Centre Forecourt. Turn left along the High Street. Uxbridge Library is about 100 metres along on the left, just after the zebra crossing and opposite Waterstones. There are lifts. Toilets (including unisex options) are on site, including on the 5th Floor.

Books by all of our authors will be on sale and you can order any titles not available for pick-up or home delivery.

From the Box Office, go diagonally across the Civic Centre Forecourt. Turn left along the High Street. Waterstones Uxbridge is about 100 metres along on the right, just after the zebra crossing and opposite the Library. The shop has a lift and also stairs. The nearest public toilets are on the lower level of the mall. There are also toilets across the street in the Library.
